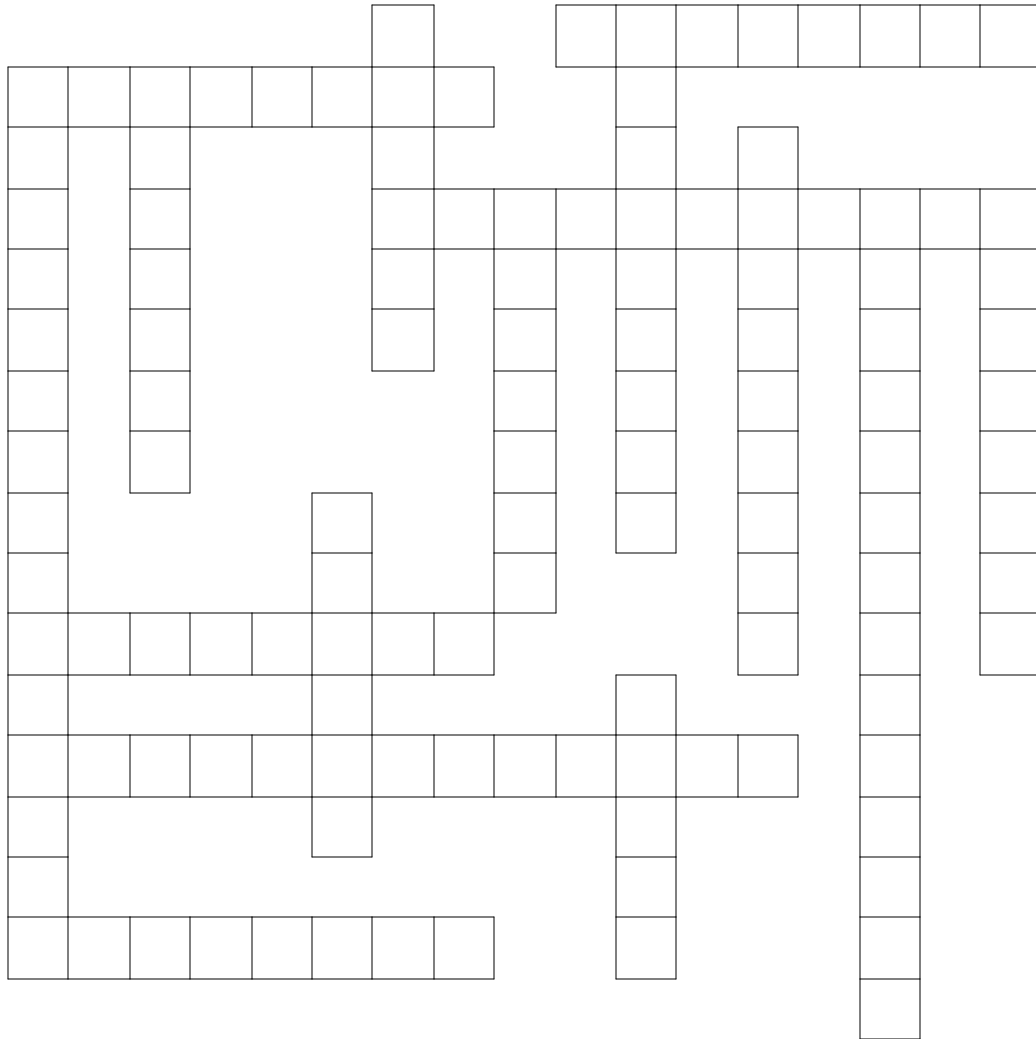


Clues listed below can help you find the words.



A detailed description of the program as a structured diagram or pseudocode. (6)

A detailed study of the problem which produces a clear description of it. (8)

A general purpose high level language. (6)

A high level language used for business programs. (5)

A loop which will continue until a condition is met. (15)

Checking the specified inputs and outputs of the program against those predicted in the design. (7)

Code which is written as a series of sub programs which can be tested independently (7)

Code written using meaningful variable and procedure names (8)

Part of a program which will return a value. (8)

Source code can be compiled to run on different platforms. (8)

Translates source code line at a time everytime the program is run. (11)

Translates source code to machine code in one operation. (8)
