- P = 1. MOGRPAR  
A list of instructions which tell the processor what to do.
- W = 2. IMWP  
Windows Icons Menus and Pointer
- P = 3. PRAOFLMGRIE  
Applications such as Access, Word or Excel, or a program created in a high level language like Visual Basic.
- M = 4. OMEREMAGNMNEMTYA  
Part of the operating system which controls where programs and data are placed in the main memory.
- P = 5. IRRITRNVEERPD  
A program which takes the codes in a document and translates them into the appropriate code for the printer.
- I = 6. TIAERTTYCMSVEENIS  
A system which carries out interactive processing.
- S = 7. AEQLSCESUNICTAES  
Reading a set of records in the same order as they were originally stored.
- E = 8. RREIRTPEORNGOR  
A message from the operating system of a computer to the user to let them know if an error has occurred.
- F = 9. IGIYFNSETLSM  
Part of the operating system that deals with files on backing storage.
- D = 10. AFETILDA  
A file containing data on backing storage or in memory. May be organised as a set of records.
- D = 11. CEISVDE  
A single item of computer hardware.
- R = 12. ROASCAENDCMS  
Being able to locate a data item straight away, whether it is stored on disk or in main memory.
- S = 13. RTIBO-DICSESRUE  
Directories that are contained within other directories.
- F = 14. OBOURGFJNODRE  
The task the user is currently working on.
- O = 15. RNIAETOYGPEMTSS  
Program which controls the operation of the computer system.
