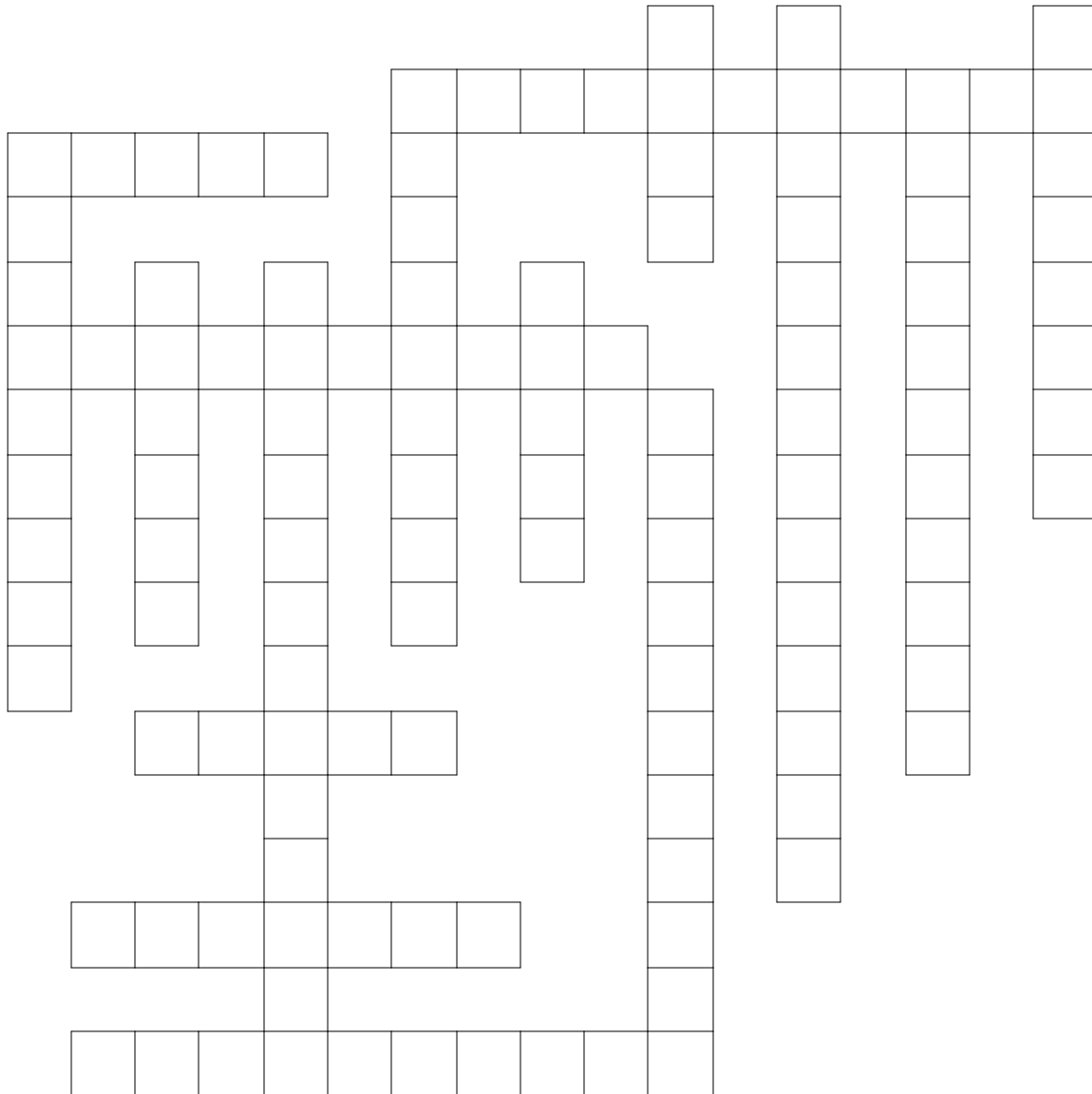


Clues listed below can help you find the words.



- A sequence of video images. (5)
- A series of pages created in a presentation package which includes sound, video, graphics and text. (6)
- Another name for a presentation. (9)
- Characters or symbols displayed on the screen. (4)
- The way in which elements of a presentation may be programmed to move around the screen. (9)
- These are links between World Wide Web pages, documents or files. They are activated by clicking on text or a graphic. (10)
- These may be of type HTML for the web, MPEG for movies, GIF or JPEG for graphics. (11)
- This is a program which leads the user step by step through the creation of a document. (7)
- This is the name given to the effect shown on the screen when moving between slides. (11)

- This is the presentation of information by a computer system using graphics, animation, sound and text. (10)
- This is the slide which controls the layout of the other slides in the presentation. (11)
- This may be added to the presentation using a microphone or a sound library. (14)
- Type of data - movies. (5)
- Type of data made up of music or sound produced by a computer. (5)
- Type of data, either bit-mapped or vector. Created using a graphics package or from a clip art library. (8)
- When slides are displayed one after the other, in the order they were created. (13)
