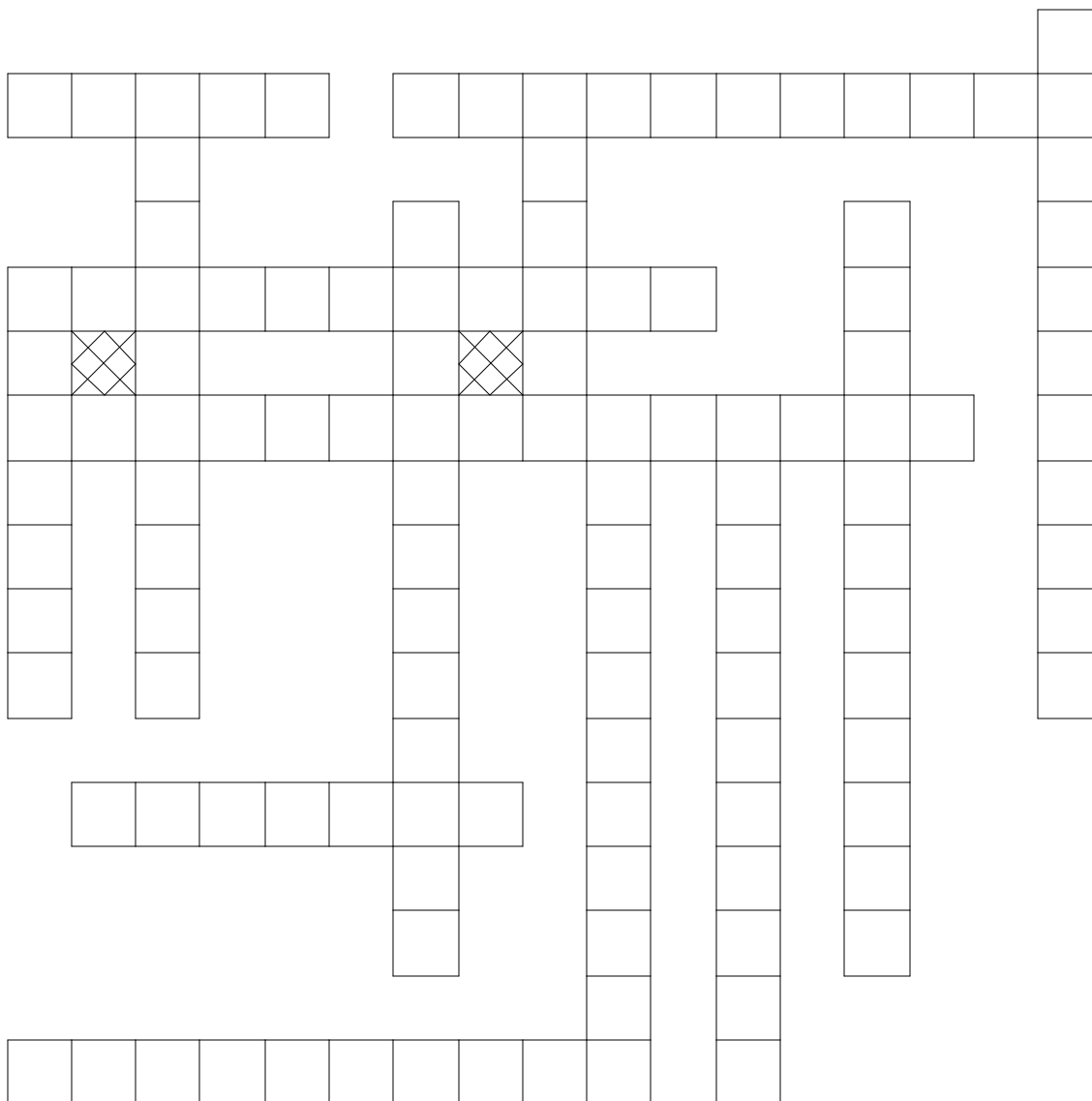


Clues listed below can help you find the words.



Beginner's **A**ll-purpose Symbolic Instruction Code. (5)

A list of instructions which tell the processor what to do. (7)

A mistake in a programming function - for example PRIN instead of PRINT. (11)

A mistake in the computer's operating system program which may stop the computer working. (11)

A mistake which causes the program to produce an unexpected result, for example, using an incorrect formula. (10)

A phrase which appears on the screen to ask the user for input. (7)

Can run a computer program written on one computer system on a different type of computer system

without altering it. (11)
