1. A device which controls the quality of the output from a computer system.
2. These speakers are mains-powered and have built-in amplifiers.
3. An output device which is adapted for a particular purpose, such as use by a disabled person or for virtual reality.
4. An output device used to reproduce the sound from a computer system.
5. A special powder used in laser printer to produce the image on paper.
6. An output device which accepts a video signal directly from a computer and displays the output on a screen.
7. Measured in pages per minute (ppm). Lasers print between 4 -32 ppm and inkjet printers between 2-15 ppm.
8. Speech produced by a computer system usually by special software and a loudspeaker.
9. Common type of monitor used. It looks like a large electric light bulb with a flat end where the image is displayed.
